He originated Abner in his one man show WICKER CHAIRS and penned WIND CHIMES AND VARICOSE CREAM which was published in the Texas Theatre Journal. His one-woman show SEAMSTRESS, was honored as Best of Fest at FronteraFest 2010. KWB will appear in an upcoming episode of DALLAS and in two upcoming films: AMNESIA, and OLYMPUS HAS FALLEN with Morgan Freeman. He is also in the films DRIVE ANGRY 3D, and ROOM—which ran at the Sundance and Cannes film Festivals.

TOM GREEN (Joey) was last seen as the Cop in Hyde Park Theatre's production of MID-DLETOWN. Last year he appeared as Levene in a chick and a dude's production of GLENGARRY GLEN ROSS. Other credits include PARADISE KEY (B.
