


Co-Op) and Sisters Under the Skin (Paradox Players). Rodnesha would like to thank friends & family for their continued support and thanks to

He has performed as accompanist and singer with Austin's Capital City Men's Chorus and is thrilled to be the founding Artistic Director for Austin Theatre Project. David is also a private vocal coach for Austin area actors and would like to thank his family, friends, and students for their unending support and encouragement!
