FROM OUR DIRECTOR

Multiple times, Clybourne Park says that you "can't live in a principle". Instead you have to live in a neighborhood.

Bruce Norris has won great acclaim for Clybourne Park, and many people point to different reasons for its success. No one, however, would argue that his success comes from answering America's questions of race and poverty and the wave of gentrification that's sweeping through cities like Austin. We might wish he did, but he doesn't. He does, though, invite us to consider our contributing principles with the people they affect. Some changes may be beneficial to many. And some may be unavoidable. And some can take advantage of those in difficult and desperate situations. And some can be deeply hurtful to our neighbors.

It's this focus on our neighbors and neighborhood that I ultimately appreciate most about the play. Reframing abstract ideals to the context of an actual neighborhood can encourage us to find flexibility at times, and at other times it can reaffirm our need to take a stand. But it's in our actual neighborhoods that I find hope that one day we might figure out how to be good neighbors. Even to our actual neighbors.

Because we live in neighborhoods and not just principles.
