Theatre Terms and Definitions

Actor: The real people in a play. Wearing costumes and make up, actors pretend to be different people (or characters). Sometimes they play more than one part.

How many actors are in The Frog Prince?

Character: The person an actor pretends to be or "play". Which actor played Prince Francis?

(Hint: look on this program carefully!)

Crew: The people who work off the stage to complete the play. They work with stage lights, sound effects and props, move scenery and curtains, and tell the actors when to begin the show.

Pirector: The person who leads the actors in the play. The Director tells actors how to say their lines, (sentences) and where to be on the stage when they speak

props did you see in <i>The Frog Prince</i> ?


