# The journey...

One of the most frequent images in folk literature is that of a character traveling through a forest in order to reach a goal. Writers explain the symbolism of the woods in these fairy tales as "the place in which inner darkness is confronted; where uncertainty is resolved about who one is ... or who one wants to be." In Into the Woods, Stephen Sondheim and James Lapine lead a group of new and old storybook characters on just such a journey of growth and self-discovery. The show deals with growing up; with relationships between parents and children; with taking responsibility; with wishfulfillment. But most tales present right and wrong in childlike terms of black and white. Here, it is served up in a cautionary tale in various shades of gray: witches tell the truth and nice people lie. Yet the character's deeds and misdeeds must finally bring them together as a community to slay the foe which threatens their very existence. Despite this, Sondheim and Lapine still offer up a far more pragmatic and affecting conclusion to Into the Woods: an affirmation of faith in mankind. a reminder that, even when things look blackest, "no one is alone."
