... is an interdisciplinary theater artist based in Austin, Texas. Zell is a beaming parent of two, Zell, IV and Blaise Marley, and proud husband of Marcia. He is winner of the David Mark Cohen award for best original script in 2007 for My Child, My Child, My Alien Child and winner of the 2008 B. Iden Payne award for best original script for Radio Silence: a word opera. He was recently awarded "Staff Member of the Year" by the Central Texas After-school Network for his after-school poetry classes. Zell is proud that out of the past four years, he has at least one of his students make the Under 21 slam team from Austin, Texas. Zell is co-artistic director of Uprise! Productions with his partner Ananda Moss, and this young company is already making major noise on the theater scene. Zell is the creator/co-producer/host of "The Hip-Hop Theater Explosion," and Zell is proud to be the host of "the make it wet spit fest" for the past five years, a Love Robinson production.

... is an HPT Core Company Member who was seen this February in The Drowned World by Gary Owen. She has also appeared in The Glory of Living and Ham for HPT. Andrea directed Sex, Drugs, Rock & Roll for HPT and is the HPT Technical Director. She designed the costume's for HPT's recent Bombs in Your Mouth.

DIRECTOR/SOUND KENWEBSTER

... is the artistic director of HPT. Last fall, he was named Outstanding Director of a Comedy at the Austin Circle of Theatre's B. Iden Payne Awards for Dog Sees God; he won the same award the previous year for The Pillowman. Last summer, he was nominated for an Austin Critics' Circle Award for directing The Pillowman and The Lonesome West. At the 2007 Austin Critics' Table Awards, he was named Outstanding Lead Actor for his one-man performances in both St. Nicholas and Thom Pain (based on nothing), both produced at HPT in 2006-7, and both of which were also nominated as Outstanding Production. In total, Webster has been nominated for 46 B. Iden Payne Awards and 21 Critics' Table Awards for acting, directing, and producing. Webster also recently appeared in Blackbird at HPT, and directed The Drowned World for the FronteraFest 2009 Long Fringe and Bombs in Your Mouth for HPT. His recent film and television credits include Waking Life, A Scanner Darkly, an episode of Friday Night Lights and the upcoming Temple Grandin. In 2006, the Austin Critics' Table inducted Webster into the Austin Arts Hall of Fame.






