Russell Hoban's novel *Riddley Walker* is set about two thousand years after the collapse of civilization. The main action of the story begins when the young narrator, Riddley, finds a buried Punch puppet and stumbles upon plans to recreate a weapon of the ancient world.

The novel's characters live a harsh, primitive life in Inland (England). Their civilization is like that of England's Iron Age, although they do not produce iron but salvage it from ancient machinery. Church and state have combined into one secretive institution, the Ram, whose policy and dogma are based on confused myths about the war and a Catholic saint (Eustace) and are conveyed through roving puppet shows. The Inlanders' dialect reflects changes that might take place in English over millennia of primitivism.
