## The Show

The show was first performed at the Limbo Lounge in New York City's East Village in 1984. It became so popular it was moved to Off-Broadway in the June of 1985.

It ran five years at the Provincetown Playhouse.

Charles Busch's playwriting style is based on movie star acting rather than naturalistic femininity. His "camp" style simultaneously sends up and celebrates the classic Hollywood genres. "I'm not sure what [campy] means," Busch has said, " but I guess if my plays have elements of old movies and old fashioned plays, and I'm this bigger-than-life star lady, that's certainly campy. I guess what I rebelled against was the notion that campy means something is so tacky or bad that it's good, and that I just didn't relate to."
